There are several roles in the Stories to Service program that require various commitment levels.

1. **Book Clubs & Volunteer Projects:** Stories to Service Book Clubs will be held 4 times a year, before the volunteer projects, to provide an opportunity for volunteers to further engage with the service projects through literature. Book Clubs will be planned by the Stories to Service Planning Committee and Teen Librarian. Book Club participants will be given a copy of the book to keep upon registration so that they may prepare for the discussion.

Stories to Service Volunteer Projects will be held 4 times a year. Project needs and physical requirements may vary depending on the decisions made by the planning committee. Volunteers may serve in 1-4 projects a year, depending on their individual availability.

2. **Planning Committee:** The Stories to Service Planning Committee will meet approximately 4 times a year to plan the program's service projects with the assistance of JCPL's Teen Librarian. They will choose which communities or organizations they would like to serve, determine what project they would like to do, and what supplies will be needed to complete the project. Planning Committee Volunteers will also be expected to participate in the Stories to Service Book Clubs and Volunteer Projects.

*All time spent volunteering for Stories to Service will be logged by the Teen Librarian. It is the responsibility of the individual volunteer to notify the Teen Librarian when he/she needs to determine the amount of volunteer hours they have earned. Please allow up to 10 days for the Teen Librarian to retrieve/sign hour logs.
